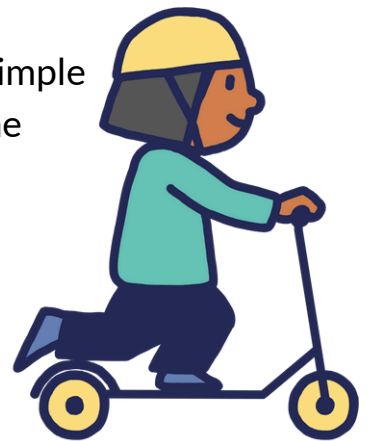
What kind of transport would you like to travel on? Where would you like to go? Be sure to make up your own verses!
